College of Arts & Crafts was established at Govind Mitra Road, Patna on 25th January 1939, by Late Shri Radha Mohan Ji. Dr. Rajendra Prasad was the first member of the Management Committee of this college. Government of Bihar took control of this famous college in the year 1949 and in the name of Government School of Arts & Crafts, it used to offer five year Diploma programmes. But, during the year 1957, the school was shifted to Vidyapati Marg, where it stands today with a newly built structure and consisting of a student's hostel as well. The institution was renamed on 12th April 1977 to Government College of Arts & Crafts and is affiliated with Patna University. The college is situated 3 km away from the Patna Railway Station and is at a distance of about 2.5 km away from Gandhi Maidan.

College of Arts & Crafts, Patna is an institution for advanced training in Visual Arts (Creative and Applied) leading to the Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree (4 year, eight semester) professional course of the Patna University. This college has been selected for center of excellence under Patna University. The objective of the teaching programme and training in the college is to achieve overall refinement of the student's perception not confined to the skills of the profession alone but also to create the right kind of intellect, as well as emotional cultivation to arrive at a level of composite creativity and thought.

## COURSE

The college runs Four-year BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS degree course of Patna University.

Course of Study: -

The four-year(Eight Semester) full time Degree course is divided into two parts :

### (A) Foundation Course:

This course is of one-year duration and is common to all the students. This course provides basic education to lay the foundation for the specialization courses. The subjects taught are Painting, Sculpture, Applied Art and Print Making.

### (B) Specialization Course:

After successful completion of above two- year foundation course, the student has to enroll in specialization course. The college offers Specialization course in the subjects as given below:

- (1) **Painting** – The objective of the three-year Specialization course in Painting is to provide the student with training in the skills for original and creative visual expression.
- (2) **Sculpture** – The techniques and processes of creating three-dimensional forms and images by carving, casting, construction or modeling etc.
- (3) **Applied Art** – Applied Art is all about communication, art and technology. It basically deals in Advertising and graphic design, giving full exposure in print media, electronic media.
- (4) **Graphics Print Making** – It is the combination of art and the technique of reproduction of art. In this subject technique is of art work printing in the traditional method on paper is being taught.

**History of Art:** This paper is compulsory and is common for all Specialization. The History of Art covering different aspects of Art and History and its appreciation comprising Indian, Chinese, Japanese and Western Art. It also includes sources of History of art, utility, cultural heritage, art and archaeology.

At the end of 4th year(Eighth Semester), University conducts final examination and grants BFA degree in particular Specialization course to the passing students.

**ADMISSION ORDINANCE OF BACHELORS IN FINE ARTS (SEMESTER SYSTEM) IN THE  
FACULTY OF FINE ARTS, PATNA UNIVERSITY**

The graduate degree Called bachelor in fine arts in the faculty of fine arts is offered in the following subjects; painting, Sculpture, Applied arts, Graphic, Print Making and History of Arts (Compulsory). The bachelor in fine arts course shall be abbreviated as B.F.A. Course and will be spread over period of four years (8 semesters).

**Admission:**

A candidate seeking admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year; semester 1(foundation course) of B.F.A. programme must have secured at least secured 45% marks at the intermediate / +2 or equivalent examination recognized by Patna university.

Admission to B.F.A. semester 1 shall be made on order of merit on the basis of marks obtain by the applicant in the admission test conducted by the college of arts & crafts, Patna.

The test shall consist of 3 papers;

**1. Memory drawing: 35 marks**

**2. Still life: 35 marks**

**3. General aptitude test: 30 marks.**

The test shall conduct in two sittings: the first sitting (paper I and II) will be of 3 hours duration. The second sitting of general aptitude will be of 30 minutes duration consisting of 30 multiple choice question based on arts, culture, history basic science, current affairs.

The merit shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the test.

1. The reservation of seats for the admission in courses shall be as per the reservation rules of the government of Bihar.

Reservation of seats

Category

**Gen.**-30 seats, **BC1**-11 seats, **BC2**-7 seats, **SC**-9 seats, **ST**-1 seat, **BC (Female)** -2 seats

2. Seat left vacant in any of the category for want of eligible candidates they shall be filled by applicants from the general category.

3. No candidate shall be entitled to the benefits of two criteria of reservation or weight ages at the same time for the purpose of admission.

4. The total number of seats for the B.F.A. shall be 60.

5. The upper age limit for admission to B.F.A. course shall be 25 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> July of the year of admission.

6. Each student shall have to pay Rs 300/- (which includes fee for appearing in the admission test) for application form and prospectus.

7. No applicants shall be admitted to the course who has not applied for the competition within the notified time or who being selected for admission does not get himself/herself admitted within the specified time except where the delay has been condoned in a special case.

8. No applicants shall be admitted who, in the opinion of vice chancellor, should not be admitted in the interest of peace, order of general discipline on the campus of Patna University.

9. The admission of any student admitted to B.F.A. may be cancelled, if it is found at any subsequent stage that the document submitted or statement made by him or her in support of his or her claim for admission is false or deceptive.

10. No candidate shall be allowed to register as a student in any additional course leading to a diploma or a degree during the academic year of his/her study for B.F.A.

3. Sons/Daughter ,Wife/Husband of teachers up to a maximum of 5% of total seats in the institutions and the courses concerned, except medical ,dental and engineering courses.
